Voluntary Payroll Protection Plan: Supplemental sick pay of \$60 per days missed from work for employees of DPS due to personal illness or injury. This benefit is funded by active employees' monthly payroll deduction of \$10 per month.

As with most school districts throughout the nation, the Denver Public Schools now requires that all outside doors be locked during school hours. This requirement includes the entrance to the Denver Teachers' Club offices. You will need to <u>call our office at 303-377-0222 prior to visiting for any reason</u>. If you stop by without calling ahead, you may be denied access.

This year our focus is going to be on getting more members in the Voluntary Payroll Protection Plan of the DPS Supplemental Benefits Program. Remember that this plan is open to all full-time employees of the Denver Public Schools. If you are a member, please try to get one of your colleagues to join. If each present member recruited just one new member it would help a lot.

I was privileged to attend the event put on by DPS for New Educators. We were able to talk to over 100 new employees of the district. It was so much fun to see young educators excited about coming to work in DPS. We also met some teachers who had left DPS and were returning. I want to welcome all of you to our district.

The Denver Teachers' Club is 120 years old this year. We are an organization where teachers work for teachers. All monies we collect go right back to our members. Your dues pay for benefits to members of the Voluntary Payroll Protection Plan who have used up their 10 or 12 yearly sick days for their own illnesses and still need to be out longer. We now pay \$60.00 a day to our members who make a claim.

The Assistance Fund is funded by our raffle, which is held in the spring, and by donations from members or retired employees who appreciate what we offer. The Assistance Fund serves all employees of the district and retirees, as well. We have all kinds of durable medical equipment that you or a member of your immediate family might need. This equipment is loaned to you and when you are finished with it you just return it to us. There is no charge to use the equipment.

I was a member of Teachers' Club my whole career. I never needed to make a claim, but I used the equipment for my family members who needed it.

PAYROLL PROTECTION PLAN BENEFIT INCREASE FOR 2017 ~ 2018

Offered through the Supplemental Benefits Program to current full-time, salaried DPS employees. Open enrollment is underway. See your representative or call our office.

Beginning July 1, 2017, the daily payment for your supplemental sick-pay benefit will increase to \$60.00 per paid claim day from the current \$50.00 per day claimed. Your cost does not change, it remains \$10.00 per month. The available benefit vesting schedule, therefore, is upgraded to the following increases:

1 st Year	5 days	\$300
2 nd Year	10 days	\$600
3 rd Year	15 days	\$900
4 th Year	20 days	\$1,200
5 th Year	25 days	\$1,500
6 th Year (Vested)	100 days	\$6,000

Once you are in your 6th year of continuous membership, you are eligible to collect up to 100 days of benefits per year, not to exceed 200 days in any five-year period.

The claim year is July 1 through June 30 of each school year. Claims for benefits for days in the July 1, 2017 - June 30, 2018 school year must be received in our office no later than September 1, 2018 to be eligible for payment. Claims require the signature of your doctor.

The Payroll Protection Plan is set up as a supplemental sick pay program after the 10 or 12 days of standard sick pay provided to you by the District. Your accumulated sick days in the Sick Leave Bank do not affect your eligibility for VPPP benefits.
