The Supplemental Benefits Program:

ASSISTANCE FUND:

Free use of durable medical equipment for all current DPS employees, DPS retirees, and immediate family members. No membership fee. Funded by donations and yearly fundraisers.

VOLUNTARY PAYROLL PROTECTION PLAN:

Supplemental sick pay of \$60 per days missed from work for employees of DPS due to personal illness or injury. This benefit is funded by active employees' monthly payroll deduction of \$10 per month.

HOLIDAY HOURS FOR THE DENVER TEACHERS CLUB: NOVEMBER 2019 WE ARE CLOSED Wednesday through Friday, the 27, 28, and 29th for the Thanksgiving holiday. We are open from 8:00 a.m. till 2:00 p.m. Monday and Tuesday November 25 and 26. For the winter holidays, we will be closed Monday **DECEMBER** 23rd through Wednesday **JANUARY** 1st. We are open Thursday the 2nd and Friday the 3rd of January from 8:00 till 2:00.

ENROLL IN THE PAYROLL PROTECTION PLAN for 2019–2020 – additional sick pay of \$60 per day is provided for active DPS employees through an employee-funded plan. We offer this unique employee benefit to all full-time employees of DPS. We often hear about DPS employees becoming ill and not taking advantage of this benefit designed to provide additional sick pay for periods of illness that cause them to be absent from work for extended amounts of time. Check out this benefit when enrolling in your other employee benefits offered to you during your Open Enrollment period, or call the Denver Teachers Club to ask about enrollment during the school year.

FREE USE OF MEDICAL EQUIPMENT AFTER RETIREMENT - To continue to borrow medical equipment free of charge from the Denver Teachers Club Assistance Fund in retirement, call us to be on our DPS retiree database and keep us informed of any changes to your contact information.

WHEN YOU DON'T NEED THE MEDICAL EQUIPMENT YOU BORROWED FROM THE DENVER TEACHERS' CLUB ANY LONGER, PLEASE RETURN IT TO US AS SOON AS YOU CAN. OTHERS MAY BE WAITING TO USE IT.

Please call ahead to reserve your medical Equipment. All entrances to the Acoma Campus are locked. As with most school districts throughout the nation, the Denver Public Schools now requires that all outside doors be locked during school hours. This requirement includes the entrance to the Denver Teachers' Club offices. You will need to <u>call our office at</u> 303-377-0222 prior to visiting for any reason. If you stop by without calling ahead, you may be denied access.

ATTENTION CURRENT EMPLOYEES OF DPS

EMPLOYEE BENEFIT: \$60.00 PER DAY IN ADDITIONAL SICK PAY PAYROLL PROTECTION PLAN FOR 2019 – 2020

Offered through the DPS Supplemental Benefits Program to current full-time, DPS employees.

The Voluntary Payroll Protection Plan (VPPP) is set up as a **supplemental sick pay benefit** available after the 10 or 12 days of standard sick pay provided to you by the District each year. Your accumulated sick days in the Sick Leave Bank do not affect your eligibility for VPPP benefits. You must enroll for this benefit by filling out an application - available online, from your Teachers' Club school/site representative, or by calling our office. This benefit is funded by and for employees of DPS through payroll deductions of \$10 per month, or \$120 once per year.

Additional sick pay available-benefit vesting schedule is as follows:

1st Year member	5 days' pay	\$300
2 nd Year member	10 days	\$600
3 rd Year member	15 days	\$900
4 th Year member	20 days	\$1,200
5 th Year member	25 days	\$1,500
6 th Year (Vested)	100 days	\$6,000

Once you are in your 6th year of continuous membership, you are eligible to collect up to 100 days of benefits <u>per</u> year, not to exceed 200 days in any five-year period.

The claim year is July 1 through June 30 of each school year. Claims for benefits for the 2018-2019 school year must be received in our office no later than September 1, 2019 to be eligible for payment. Claims require the signature of your doctor and HR sick leave approval.
