The Supplemental Benefits Program:

ASSISTANCE FUND:

Free use of durable medical equipment for all current DPS employees, DPS retirees, and immediate family members. No membership fee. Funded by donations and yearly fundraisers.

VOLUNTARY PAYROLL PROTECTION PLAN:

Supplemental sick pay of \$60 per days missed from work for employees of DPS due to personal illness or injury. This benefit is funded by active employees' monthly payroll deduction of \$10 per month.

ENROLL IN THE PAYROLL PROTECTION PLAN for 2019–2020 – additional sick pay of \$60 per day, see page 9. Claims for payment for the 2018-2019 school year are due to us no later than September 1, 2019.

Throughout the many years of the Denver Teachers Club:

The Denver Teachers' Club was organized on March 27, 1897. It is the oldest non-profit in the state of Colorado, incorporated in 1911. The original constitution and bylaws were adopted April 6, 1897. The name – The Denver Teachers' Club, and the objectives of the Club were stated as to advance the interests of the schools, to raise the standard of the profession, to cultivate a spirit of sympathy and good will among teachers, and to form a representative body able to speak with authority for teachers. To date, it remains the only organization of its kind in the United States.

All members who joined the Club prior to May 5, 1897 were considered charter members. Founding charter and other early members of the Club include prominent members of the Denver school district at the turn of the century, who went on to have schools named in their honor: Barrett, Brown, Carson, Eagleton, Force, Griffith, Gove, Greenlee, Knapp, Merrill, Moore, Philips, Remington, Sabin, Skinner, Smiley, Smith, Whiteman, Wyatt.

The majority of meetings during the first five years took place in the auditorium of East Denver High School, and in the office of then superintendent William H. Smiley. The Club assigned a committee representing teachers of Denver and other area cities to address the National Education Association convention in July of 1897. The first two important issues addressed were to increase the number of women in the management of the NEA, and to secure appropriation to investigate serious obstacles in schools of the United States with the current assignment of from 50 to 60 pupils per teacher.

With its various established committees, the Club's Hospital Committee was asked to investigate the feasibility of securing a hospital room in the Denver area for use by Club members. The early version of our current **Voluntary Payroll Protection Plan** (then called the DTC Indemnity) was proposed in May of 1903 at the benefit payment of \$10 per week from the beginning of the second week of illness, not to exceed four weeks. In November of 1903 the board unanimously passed a resolution that \$.50 out of each member's yearly dues be set aside for a hospital fund.

The first Club hospital room was secured at the Denver Homeopathic in May of 1903 at a cost of \$10 per week, furnished with all the necessary and available medical equipment for a total cost of \$100 paid for by the Club. A wheelchair from this initial purchase is on display in the Club location today. The hospital room could be used at the hospital director's discretion for other patients unless it was needed by a member of the DPS. Continued monetary donations to the Club for various purposes led to the eventual establishment of a separate fund for teachers needs, now known as **The Assistance Fund of the Denver Teachers Club**.

In March 3, 1898, another committee of the organization was established and was instrumental in the development of state legislation providing the pensioning of teachers in 1903. The Club also joined the Women's Club of Denver in 1904 to address a convention of the Libraries of America citing the needful reform "in administration, the shelves of our library be open and free to the public, and as an educational factor, our national library system should be second only to our system of public schools."

In our desire to continue this significant measure of service to the DPS community, the Club acknowledges all our contributors' assistance in time, effort, and donations. We could not do it without you. If you would like to be a member of our volunteer 'Helping Hands', please call us to be put on our list. ATTENTION CURRENT EMPLOYEES OF DPS

EMPLOYEE BENEFIT: \$60.00 PER DAY IN ADDITIONAL SICK PAY PAYROLL PROTECTION PLAN FOR 2019 – 2020

Offered through the DPS Supplemental Benefits Program to current full-time, DPS employees.

The Voluntary Payroll Protection Plan (VPPP) is set up as a **supplemental sick pay benefit** available after the 10 or 12 days of standard sick pay provided to you by the District each year. Your accumulated sick days in the Sick Leave Bank do not affect your eligibility for VPPP benefits. You must enroll for this benefit by filling out an application - available online, from your Teachers' Club school/site representative, or by calling our office. This benefit is funded by and for employees of DPS through payroll deductions of \$10 per month, or \$120 once per year.

Additional sick pay available-benefit vesting schedule is as follows:

1 st Year member	5 days' pay	\$300
2 nd Year member	10 days	\$600
3 rd Year member	15 days	\$900
4 th Year member	20 days	\$1,200
5 th Year member	25 days	\$1,500
6 th Year (Vested)	100 days	\$6,000

Once you are in your 6th year of continuous membership, you are eligible to collect up to 100 days of benefits per year, not to exceed 200 days in any five-year period.

The claim year is July 1 through June 30 of each school year. **Claims for benefits for the 2018-2019 school year must be received in our office no later than September 1, 2019 to be eligible for payment.** Claims require the signature of your doctor and HR sick leave approval.
